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Change Log from 2018:

- Rename category **American IPA** to **Standard IPA** to make it more obvious that New England IPA is included
- Rename category **German Wheat and Rye** to **Wheat & Rye Beer** to allow non-German styles
- Move **Witbier** from **Belgian & French Ale** to **Wheat & Rye Beer**
- Combine/split **Sour Ale** and **American Wild** into **Brett Beer**, **Sour Beer**, **Specialty Wild & Sour Beer**
 - This brings wild beer categories more in line with sensory characteristics, rather than historical context
 - Left **Catharina Sour** in **Fruit Beer** since *“the flavor and aroma of the fruit (should) be the primary focus of the beer”*

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
